- I declare and guarantee to be the exclusive owner, or otherwise a subject having full exclusive availability of all rights including - by way of example and not exhaustive - those of intellectual property and copyright, relating to the photographs sent to scatti.biblioteca@unicatt.it as part of the "Shots in the Library" contest (hereinafter referred to as the "Photos");
- I transfer to the CATHOLIC UNIVERSITY OF THE SACRED HEART (hereinafter also "University") every pecuniary right, including intellectual property rights, relating to the photos (hereinafter the "Rights"). The rights include, among other things, the ability to: (i) reproduce and/or transfer the Photos to other formats and/or make copies thereof, in whole or in part, in any way and/or form, by any reproduction process; (ii) edit or process, in whole or in part, the photos by any means and on any medium; (iii) communicate, transmit, and/or distribute the Photos to the public by any means and current remote distribution system (such as, for example, the internet and telecommunications networks, radio and television, telephony, etc.), using any technology and technical tool, in any form and with any access method;
- I declare and guarantee that the photos are original and do not contain images, works, materials, and/or elements of any kind owned by third parties and that nothing contained therein is obscene, violent, defamatory, blasphemous, gruesome, or likely to disturb minors or violate the rights, pecuniary or personal, of third parties or legal provisions;
- I declare and guarantee that I have obtained broad consent from the subjects portrayed in the Photos in order to produce the same photograph;
- I declare and guarantee to indemnify the University and its assignees from any claim, challenge, dispute - even in court - that may arise in relation to the exploitation of the Photos by the University;
- I declare not to claim any compensation for the transfer of rights and acknowledge that the actual exploitation and use of the Photos will occur at the exclusive discretion of the University.

Owner and Data Controller of Personal Data (Legislative Decree 196/2003)

"1. The data subject has the right to obtain confirmation as to whether or not personal data concerning him or her exist, even if not yet recorded, and their communication in intelligible form. // 2. The data subject has the right to obtain indication: // a) of the origin of personal data; // b) of the purposes and methods of the processing; // c) of the logic applied in case of processing carried out with the aid of electronic instruments; // d) of the identifying details of the data controller, data processors, and the representative designated pursuant to article 5, paragraph 2; // e) of the subjects or categories of subjects to whom the personal data may be communicated or who may become aware of it as designated representative in the territory of the State, data processors, or persons in charge. // 3. The data subject has the right to obtain: // a) updating, rectification, or, when interested, integration of the data; // b) erasure, anonymization, or blocking of data that have been processed unlawfully, including data whose retention is unnecessary for the purposes for which they have been collected or subsequently processed; // c) certification that the operations referred to in letters a) and b) have been notified, also as regards their contents, to those to whom the data were communicated or disclosed, unless this requirement proves impossible or involves a manifestly disproportionate effort compared to the right being protected. // 4. The data subject has the right to object, in whole or in part: // a) on legitimate grounds, to the processing of personal data concerning him or her, even though they are relevant to the purpose of the collection; // b) to the processing of personal data concerning him or her, where it is carried out for the purpose of sending advertising materials or direct selling or else for the performance of market research or commercial communication."
